Top Ten Questions being asked about SMC/Mebane Campus Transition

1. **What is the date for the last weekend worship service at the Mebane campus?** The last worship service at our Mebane campus will be Sunday morning, February 27. Don't miss it. It's going to be an amazing story weekend.
2. **Will the Life on Center office in downtown Mebane remain open?** Yes! The Life on Center office will remain open for our groups, Bible studies and various other meetings and ministries being offered to the Mebane community.
3. **What about 'Crossings/Mebane' 'our Middle and High School Ministry?** SMC realizes the difficulty that most middle and high school students face when attempting to get plugged into a Student Ministry located 15 miles away. We are committed to keeping our 'Crossings/Mebane' ministry open and meeting at the Life on Center office. 4. **How does SMC plan to help us transition our kids, infants '5th grade to the children's ministry in Burlington?** Helping your child feel settled and safe in one of our childcare environments is important to their overall weekend experience. This is usually a result of the familiar faces of childcare volunteers that welcome them each weekend. SMC is asking all current childcare volunteers to assist our Mebane kids transition by serving at the Burlington campus. 5. **Will I be able to get plugged in and volunteer at the Burlington campus?** Yes! If you are currently serving at the Mebane campus or desire to find a place of service, SMC will help you make the transition. 6. **Will there still be Bible studies, small groups and outreach events for Mebane?** Yes! SMC plans to continue all our current Mebane groups, studies and outreach opportunities as well as assist you in creating new ones.
7. **Would SMC ever consider reopening the Mebane campus for weekend worship?** If an opportunity for a space that would accommodate the needs of the Mebane campus became available, SMC would consider a re-launch.
8. **If worshipping at the Burlington campus isn't an option, how do I (or my family) get plugged in to another church in the Mebane area?** While there are several great churches in and around the Mebane community, SMC realizes that not all churches attract and meet the needs of every person. It is our goal during this transition to assist you in finding a church home. If that's not at SMC/Burlington, then we can offer you other churches to consider.
