Matthew 23: 3a // NLT

So practice and obey whatever they tell you, but don't follow their example. For they don't practice what they teach.

Matthew 23: 3 // NLT

Everything they do is for show.

Matthew 23: 5 // NLT

When they are in the market, they like to have people greet them as their teachers. But none of you should be called a teacher. You have only one teacher, and all of you are like brothers and sisters.

Matthew 23: 7-8 // CEV

Whoever is your servant is the greatest among you.

Matthew 23: 11 // NCV

But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut the kingdom of heaven in people's faces. You neither enter yourselves nor allow those who would enter to go in.

What sorrow awaits you teachers of religious law and you Pharisees. Hypocrites! For you are careful to tithe even the tiniest income from your herb gardens K but you ignore the more important aspects of the law — justice, mercy, and faith.

You should tithe, yes, but do not neglect the more important things K but you ignore the more important aspects of the law — justice, mercy, and faith.
